



## **Maine, New Brunswick, Prince Edward Is. And Nova Scotia Road trip For Jon and Linda**

### **July 19<sup>th</sup>**

**Flights- Departure – Leave Sioux Falls 6:00am and land in Atlanta at 9:28am  
Leave Atlanta 3:07pm and land in Portland, Maine 5:54pm**

**Rental Car – Alamo Full-size/4-Door/Automatic with air and Unlimited Miles. Estimated \$113.93 for taxes and fees will be payable to the rental car company when you pick up your vehicle.**

### **July 20<sup>th</sup>**

Travel onto Bar Harbor, take I-295 to Topsham, ME, US Route 1 to Ellsworth, ME, and Route 3 to Acadia/Bar Harbor.

Places to see on the way could be Camden, ME with its nice little harbor. The Penobscot Narrows Bridge Observatory, just off US Route 1 in Bucksport, ME. Stop at Acadia National Park Visitor's Center on Route 3. The Rangers/Staff there can help you plan your Park Visit to get the most out of your time there.

While in Bar Harbor, your Sunset Whale Watching Tour starts at 4:30. You will want to be there per the Tour Company, 60-90min prior.

### **July 21<sup>st</sup>**

\*You will lose an hour when you cross the border from the USA into Canada.

Travel to St. John, New Brunswick, via US Route 1. You can take Route 182, an Official Scenic Byway from Hancock, ME to Cherryfield, Me and then rejoin Route 1; Reversing Tide Park in Perry, ME; and then maybe if time Fundy National Park in New Brunswick.

**Travel time and Distance from Bar Harbor to St. Johns- 185 miles 3 hours and 34 min**

You will want to time it so that you get to St. John's about 12:30-1pm to get in-line to catch the ferry across the Bay of Fundy, over to Digby, NS. This ferry leaves at 2:15pm (Tidbit of info about Digby, if you like scallops, this is the scallop capital of the world!) You will have a Booking Confirmation printed off in you packet for the ferry.

Travel on to Halifax, Nova Scotia. Either today or before you leave Halifax, you could take a trip down the Atlantic Coast to Peggy's Cove, a very photogenic spot.

### **July 22<sup>rd</sup>**

Travel to Cape Breton Highlands National Park, Nova Scotia. You can take the Cabot Trail around the National Park. Travel Time and Distance – 203 Miles about 3 hours and 30 min

### **July 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup>**

Then travel to Caribou, Nova Scotia to catch the ferry across the Northumberland Strait. This is a 75-min route to Wood Islands, Prince Edward Island. You are booked on the 11:15am ferry, so I would try to be there about an hour before it departs. You will have a Booking Confirmation printed off for you in your packet.

Travel time from Ingonish Beach to Caribou is 191 miles  
3 hours to 33 min.

**You will then travel to Georgetown from Wood Is. To go on your Starfish Hunting Tour. Head west on MacMillan Ln toward Trans-Canada Hwy/PE-1**

**Turn right onto Trans-Canada Hwy/PE-1 E**

**Turn Left onto Wood Islands Rd/PE-315 N**

**Turn left onto PE-4 N (Signs for Prince Edward Island 4/Montague/Souris)**

**At the Roundabout, continue straight to stay on PE-4 N**

**At the Roundabout, take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit onto Georgetown RD/PE-3 E**

**Turn right onto Kayes Rd/PE-343 E**

**The destination will be on the right.**

**Continue straight (Signs for Trans-Canada Hwy/Prince Edward Island 1/Charlottetown)**

**Turn Right onto Trans-Canada Hwy/PE-1 W**

**Sharp left onto Water St (signs for Trans Canada Hwy/PE-1)**

**Turn Left onto Prince St**

**Destination will be on the left- They are behind the restaurant Lobster on the Wharf**

**Turn left toward Georgetown Rd/PE-3 E**

**Continue onto Georgetown Rd/PE-3 E**

**At the roundabout, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit and stay on Georgetown RD/PE-3 E**

**It should be on the left.**
